The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 27, 2011, Grant Wilson (Complainant) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia), alleging Columbia wrongfully billed Complainant for gas service to 22 East Welch Ave., Columbus, Ohio, between April 2009 and December 2010. Complainant states that he sold the property in July 2007, and informed Columbia that he no longer owns the property.
- (2) On July 18, 2011, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss the complaint. In its motion, Columbia provides that it has spoken with Complainant and verbally resolved all of the issues raised in the complaint. Columbia asserts that Complainant indicated to Columbia that he no longer seeks to pursue the complaint, and no further proceedings are necessary.
- (3) In accordance with Rule 4901-1-9-01(F), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Complainant was permitted to file a written response to Columbia's motion to dismiss the complaint within 20 days after service of the motion to indicate whether he agrees or disagrees with Columbia's assertions. Rule 4901-1-9-01(F), O.A.C. provides that, if no response is filed within the prescribed time period, the Commission may presume that satisfaction or settlement has occurred and dismiss the complaint. No response was filed in this case regarding the motion to dismiss.
- (4) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss the complaint is reasonable and should be granted.
