1.1 Late Payment Charge

If payment for a current bill is received by the Company before the bill's due date, but for technical or other reasons the payment is notapplied to the customer's account prior to the issuance of a subsequent bill, the customer shall not be liable for that portion of any unpaid balance attributable to a Late Payment Charge.

A customer shall not be liable for any Late Payment Chargeapplicable to a disputed portion of that customer's bill, so long as the customer pays the undispted portion of the bill and enters into bona fide negotiations to resolve the dispute. Agencies of the Federal government are exemptfrom the Late Payment Charge.
