The attorney examiner finds:


- (1) On July 22, 2011, Snyder, Laurie Residence - L Snyder (Snyder) filed an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Pursuant to Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), this application is subject to a 60-day automatic approval process. The rule also provides the Commission may suspend an application during the 60-day approval process.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that additional information and investigation is necessary to thoroughly review the application. Therefore, good cause exists to suspend the automatic 60-day approval process for Snyder's application for certification, in order for the Commission and its staff to further review this matter.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the automatic approval process for the application of Snyder for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource facility be suspended.  
It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record in these cases.
