The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 17, 2011, Kelly Hinkley (Complainant) filed a complaint against The East Ohio Gas Company, d/b/a Dominion East Ohio (DEO), seeking reimbursement for usage, investigation, and reconnection fees, as well as plumbing costs that resulted from relocating Ms. Hinkley's meter. On July 11, 2011, DEO filed its answer to the complaint.
- (2) Pursuant to entry issued July 20, 2011, a settlement conference was held on August 8, 2011.
- (3) On August 31, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss this case with prejudice. The parties explain that all matters in this action have been settled and that the parties have executed a confidential settlement agreement.
- (4) The Commission finds that the joint motion to dismiss, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

ORDERED, That the joint motion to dismiss be granted and that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,
