THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 20, 2011, Medina Smokehouse/Medina Foods Inc. (complainant) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia) alleging that Columbia inappropriately terminated complainant's gas service on October 13, 2010, upon discovering that complainant's gas line was exposed where it crossed a creek behind complainant's meat processing plant. Because of Columbia's actions, complainant claims that it lost more than two days of productions that resulted in cancelled orders, overtime to catch up from the loss of production, loss of \$141,768.05 in product, and losses related to the rental home on the property which was also without gas service. Complainant requests compensation for those losses. On June 9, 2011, Columbia filed its answer to the complaint.
- (2) Pursuant to an entry issued June 16, 2011, a settlement conference was held on July 19, 2011.
- (3) On October 3, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss this case. In the motion, the parties assert that they have resolved all of the issues raised in this case.
- (4) In light of the parties' October 3, 2011, motion, the Commission finds that the parties' request to dismiss the complaint, given that they have reached an agreement which resolves the issues raised in the complaint, is reasonable. Accordingly, the request to dismiss the complaint should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the parties' request to dismiss the complaint be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 11-3148-GA-CSS be dismissed. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
