ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On June 17, 2011, Michael and Jeanne Schroeder (the Schroeders) filed a complaint against the Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI), alleging that in March 2011 a power surge destroyed numerous appliances in their home. The Schroeders contend that they had notified CEI several months earlier that a nearby power line had been sparking, but CEI failed to respond.
- (2) CEI filed its answer on July 7, 2011. CEI admitted that it responded to the Schroeders' service call in January 2011 and did not find any issues with their service. CEI also admitted that, in March 2011, a primary line owned by CEI near the Schroeders' address had fallen and burned. CEI stated that it repaired the power line and conductor. CEI denied any other allegations made by the Schroeders.
- (3) By entry issued August 18, 2011, the attorney examiner scheduled a September 12, 2011, settlement conference. However, prior to September 12, 2011, counsel for CEI notified the attorney examiner that the parties had agreed upon a settlement.
- (4) On October 24, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The joint motion indicates that the parties have

resolved all issues and claims in the complaint. In addition, the parties request that the case be dismissed with prejudice.

(5) The Commission finds that the parties' motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint, with prejudice, is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That Case No. 11-3657-EL-CSS be dismissed with prejudice. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
