

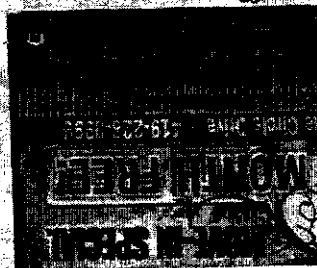

3Q a dandy for AEP as profit, sales rise

Hot weather and a legal victory in Texas helped American Electric Power post an increase in third-quarter profit and sales.

The Columbus-based utility had \$928 million in net income, up from \$565 million in the same quarter in 2010 and \$4.3 billion in sales, up from \$4.1 billion in 2010.

"In this business, warmer-than-normal weather is a blessing on occasion," Michael Morris, AEP's chairman and CEO, said in a conference call with analysts.
