## <u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- On June 13, 2011, Mr. Thomas S. Hughart (complainant) filed a complaint against the Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) in which he claimed that DP&L issued an inaccurate bill with excessive charges.
- (2) On June 29, 2011, DP&L filed an answer, motion to dismiss, and request for mediation. For its answer, DP&L denied the material allegations of the complaint.
- (3) On September 12, 2011, the attorney examiner scheduled a conference to provide the parties an opportunity to resolve the complaint informally.
- (4) On October 20, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss. The parties explain that they have entered into a full and comprehensive settlement and have resolved all claims and issues. The parties, therefore, request that the complaint be dismissed with prejudice.
- (5) Upon being advised by the parties that the issues raised by the complaint have been resolved, the Commission concludes that the joint motion to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted.
