Though a settlement between Ohio reg ulators and American Electric Power Ohio would not raise utility rates, consumers could still see their monthly bills increase by \$1 or \$2.

construction, but was told to not collect from customers it until more competition entered the market. The agreement also has AEP Ohio giving \$1 million annually from January 2012 to May 2015 to help low-income customers pay their electric-ity bills.
