Exhibit C - Description of Proposed Change

Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company LLC ("CBT") is revising its Local Service Tariff, PUCO No. 1, to add anniversary dates and revise the maximum prices for Lifeline BLES services. ILECs were prohibited from altering Lifeline BLES rates upwards prior to January 1, 2012, pursuant to 4901:1-6-14 (E) O.A.C. As CBT noted in its tariff, the Company will establish "anniversary dates" defining the price flexibility for Lifeline BLES once price flexibility becomes effective for Lifeline BLES customers. This filing establishes these anniversary dates and revises the maximum rates in accordance with 4901:1-6-4 (C) O.A.C.

Customer notice is not required with this filing and none has been provided. If CBT utilizes this price flexibility in the future, CBT will provide customer notice, as appropriate, to coincide with the price changes for Lifeline BLES.
