Because the deadlines for discovery and submission of testimony established in this case are approaching rapidly, the Consumers' Coalition also seeks an expedited ruling on this Motion. ### MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

On October 6, 1997 the Attorney Examiner issued an Entry establishing a hearing schedule in this proceeding. The Entry schedules mediation to commence on October 21, 1997, discovery to be completed by November 3, 1997, Ameritech's expert testimony to be filed November 4, 1997, joint movants testimony to be filed by November 6, 1997 with the hearing to commence on November 12, 1997.

The Consumer Coalition requests that the Hearing date in this matter and the associated discovery and testimony filing dates be continued for 60 days.

This matter has been set for hearing on the Motion of the Consumer Coalition, there will be no prejudice to Ameritech from the granting of this continuance, and Ameritech does not object to a continuance.

The Consumer Coalition requests this continuance for several reasons.

First, Ameritech's response to the Edgemont Neighborhood Coalition and the American Association of Retired Person's first set of discovery, which was served on Ameritech by fax on September 25, 1997, was due, pursuant to the Commission's Entry of October 6, 1997, no later than October 9, 1997. It was not until October 14, 1997 that counsel for Edgemont received a "partial response" to that discovery. The other coalition members did not receive any of the discovery response materials until October 16, 1997. This delay has held up further discovery.

Second, the Consumer Coalition is in the process of arranging an expert witness for this case, Nancy Brockway of the National Consumer Law Center. We have not yet been able to finalize arrangements with Ms. Brockway and there are questions about her ability to prepare

testimony by the November 6, 1997 cut-off date.

Third, this matter has been set for Mediation to commence October 21, 1997. The mediation should proceed as scheduled. A continuance of the hearing date will allow time to insure that the possibilities for a negotiated resolution of this case are fully explored.

Finally, Counsel for the movants in this case are involved in a number of other telecommunications cases which are set for hearing before the Commission this fall. The cases include Case No. 97-539-TP-ACE, Case No. 97-397-TP-ACE, Case No. 96-926-TP-ACE, and Case No. 97-597-TP-UNC. A continuance is needed in order to allow time to properly prepare this case.

In summary, the Consumer Coalition filed the Motion which lead to this hearing. We have every interest and desire to see this case proceed expeditiously, however, we want to make sure there is sufficient time to properly prepare this case for hearing as well as to fully explore possibilities for settlement. For those reasons, and because Ameritech does not object to a continuance, the Coalition asks that a 60 day continuance of the hearing date be granted.

Finally, because important cut-off dates are quickly approaching. The Coalition asks for an expedited ruling on this Motion.
