ENTRY

The administrative law judge finds:

- (1) On October 26, 2011, Hog Creek Wind Farm, LLC (Hog Creek or company) filed a motion for a protective order in each of the above-referenced cases, requesting, in part, that the Ohio Power Siting Board (Board) keep the REpower MM 100 turbine safety manual confidential.
- (2) In its November 28, 2011, orders issued in these cases, the Board found that Hog Creek should file an amended motion for a protective order by December 14, 2011, for the REpower MM100 safety manual, specifically identifying the information on each page of the REpower MM100 safety manual that Hog Creek believed should be considered a trade secret.
- (3) On December 14, 2011, Hog Creek requested an extension of time to file its amended motion for a protective order. Thereafter, by entry dated December 16, 2011, the administrative law judge granted Hog Creek's request for extension of time, until January 13, 2012, to file its amended motion.
- (4) On January 13, 2012, Hog Creek filed notices of withdrawal of its request for protective treatment. In the notices, Hog Creek

stated that, after further consultation with the manufacturer of the REpower MM100 safety manual, the company will not be filing an amended motion and that it is withdrawing its request for confidential treatment of the REpower MM100 safety manual.


- (5) In light of Hog Creek's decision to withdraw its request for protective treatment, the attorney examiner directs the Commission's docketing division to release the REpower MM100 safety manual, filed in the above-referenced dockets on October 26, 2011, into the public record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the Commission's docketing division release into the public record the company's REpower MM100 safety manual, filed in the above-referenced dockets on October 26, 2011. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon Hog Creek and all interested persons of record.


