Subject: AEP rate hike

Message: As treasurer of a small homeowners association in Columbus, each month I pay 12 AEP bills. Ten are unmetered service for security lights and such. Two are metered. I was surprised to learn that the large increases in AEP's "distribution service charges" would apply to us. AEP classifies all our accounts as "commercial", even though we are not a business and do not engage in commerce of any sort. We are just a not-for-profit HOA, but AEP refuses to change any of our rate tariff codes. Our January AEP bills are up 30%-40% for the unmetered accounts. One metered account is up 67%, and the other is up an astounding 450%! This is both absurd and unaffordable. We protest being classified by AEP as "commercial". It is untrue and unfair. AEP's new rates are excessive, especially for organizations such as ours, and will create financial problems for us. On behalf of our HOA and others like us, we demand an immediate reclassification by AEP to more appropriate, less costly rate tariff codes similar to residential codes and rates.
