My electric bill has more than doubled compared to last year and we have not even had any cold weather in Ohio. I put all new Energy Efficient windows in my entire house in October, changed to the energy saving light bulbs and keep my thermostat set well below 70. There is no way my bill for last month could have been \$286.27 and this month its \$305.83. My highest bill last winter (2011) for the coldest month was about \$285. I am a single mother and its only me and my son who live in our house. We have ceiling heat and dont even have the heat on in 3 rooms upstairs and no heat on in the basement.

I called AEP and they had me take a reading off my meter so they could adjust my bill. When I called them back with the reading, they told me that my bill should actually be HIGHER than \$305.83 I have a good job and I can not afford these kinds of bills. I can not even imagine what people who arent as fortunate as I am are going to do when winter does hit. AEP is going to really hurt a lot of people in Ohio. What else can I do? Write my Congressman...write to the President? Thank You for allowing me to send in my complaint.

#### **COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:**

My home in an all electric home in Powell. My January bill was 35% higher than December (up \$120) even though less electricity was used. I complained to AEP and they could not explain how my bill was calculated so I could at least figure out the new tariffs and how I would be effected in future months. Rates WERE different during the summer and winter.

I have complained in the past that my tariff rate (018) which utilizes a large off peak water heater with a timer and has a discount - has slowly been reduced over the years each time a new tariff was implemented. Again the changes in rates and how they are applied has not been communicated and the rationale for them is hidden.

How do you expect consumers to make informed and timely decisions on energy use when rates are being manipulated and are never communicated and reasons are not transparent?

Bottom line - do you think that a homeowner should open an electric bill that is 35% higher than the previous month having used LESS electricity and have no clue this is coming and how it was determined? I can't even find out if my off peak water heater credit will be continued if I go to a new supplier. Some credits appear to be on distribution and some on generation. In the past AEP lied (yes lied in writing) about my rates and credits. Their answer was that customer service was not informed to explain how bills were calculated. Is it not reasonable that a homeowner should be able to understand how is bill is calculated and be able to predict how it will be calculated while a rate is in place? And when the new rates are put in place that he understand the change?

You need to fix this quickly but you have done a terrible job in managing this.
