



How could the generation charges go from \$104.89 last month to \$161.44 this month? That is a total of \$190.00 increase in 1 month. How could this be possible? Our bill last month was \$149.46 & this month \$353.09. The weather has been quite mild & we use a gas fireplace almost daily to take the chill off the rooms we're in. We also added a new energy efficient insulated roof last May. We felt it made a huge change in the cooling of our house, even with the heat of the summer. The bill last month was estimated with 1084 KWH & the bill this month was actual with 2804 KWH. The only bill close in comparison would be the second one of 2011 with an estimated of 3894 KWH. The distribution charges were \$119.77 & the generation charges were \$261.82. Who estimated that bill? The other 11 months averaged

together are 1244 KWH. So why would anyone estimate our bill at that rate of KWH at any time of the year? Please look up our records & do the math. Please explain how you are allowed to just charge any amount you want with no explanation? We deserve an answer.

COMPLAINT DESCRIPTION:

I am submitting the following regarding case 11-346-EL-SSO. I have included a brief background of my company, the impact of the rate increase, and the consequences of the rate change.

Background The Logan Clay Products Company operates two manufacturing facilities in

Hocking County. Logan Clay manufacturers sewer pipe and chimney flue lining in Logan, while Sawmiller LLC manufactures wood pallets in Haydenville. Sawmiller LLC is on the a Columbus Southern tariff while Logan Clay is on the an Ohio Power tariff. Between these two facilities, the company provides over 100 full time jobs. AEP Rate Increase Sawmiller LLC's January invoice from American Electric Power (AEP) for transmission increased from \$.043/KWH to \$.108/KWH. This is a 151% increase and will result in an annual increase of approximately \$75,000. If this increase is not reduced, the company will be forced to eliminate three positions and/or significantly reduce healthcare benefits. The increase in cost also threatens the long-term viability of the company, as it may no longer be competitive in the marketplace. Logan Clay's transmission costs increased from \$.019 in December to \$.037 in January. This is an increase of 85% and will result in an annual increase of \$45,000. If Logan Clay is forced to absorb this cost, the company will be forced to eliminate 2 positions and/ or significantly reduce healthcare benefits. Conclusion If our company takes action to retain our current cost structure the rate increase will directly cause the loss of 5 or more jobs in an area that has far too few jobs to begin with. Our company may also need to reduce health care and other benefits for the remaining employees in order to survive. Still, it may be impossible to compete with manufacturers operating in areas where distribution is provided by utilities not using a "market" system that penalizes small manufacturers. This AEP distribution charge, implemented now or phased in over a number of years, jeopardizes over 100 jobs in Appalachia. As such, we respectfully request that the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio repeal this rate plan and not allow a rate plan that puts small businesses in American Electric Power's service area at a competitive disadvantage.

Thank you for contacting the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio regarding your electric bill from American Electric Power (AEP).

The PUCO is troubled by the affected AEP customers' concerns, and we are currently evaluating bills and exploring possible ways to mitigate rate impacts going forward. In January, the PUCO granted rehearing on variety of AEP rate case issues is fully committed to quickly addressing the situation.

The PUCO is responsible for ensuring that utilities across the state provide safe and reliable service. Also, great care is taken to review the financial records of utility companies to ensure that the rates set by the PUCO do not result in over-collection of revenue. This is a responsibility we take seriously.

In January 2011, AEP filed an electric security plan (ESP) for the supply and pricing of electric generation service, and separately, an application for an increase in distribution rates. In September, 20 parties submitted a negotiated agreement resolving issues in both the ESP and the distribution rate case. The PUCO publicly vetted the agreement during 13 days of hearing, and on December 14, 2011, approved the agreement with modification. In modifying the ESP, the PUCO lowered the base generation rate increases to half of what was proposed in the agreement. Additionally, the PUCO expanded a credit offered to small business customers that choose an alternate supplier.

The ESP establishes a path for customers to receive their electricity from fully competitive markets. To that end, beginning in June 2015, electric supply for AEP's customers will be procured through a PUCO-approved competitive auction. Similar auctions for other Ohio utilities have resulted in savings for their customers.

As a customer on a commercial tariff, the price increases you are experiencing are the result of certain new charges and, at the same time, expiration of certain credits to bills that had been in place. A fundamental impact to bills are new charges designed to recover millions of dollars worth of previously-approved distribution and fuel costs that had been deferred over the course of the past decade.

Customers have been impacted to varying degrees, and the degree of an individual bill increase is largely dependent upon the customer's energy usage pattern. Customers can reduce their usage by making energy efficiency upgrades. AEP offers the Express Program for small businesses to save energy and money. Small businesses with annual energy consumption of 200,000 kilowatt hours (kWh) or less, based on the last 12 months of billing history, can participate. For more information on the Express Program, call KEMA, AEP Ohio's program implementer for this program, at 877-607-0739. (especially when we have electric heat and we have made SEVERE heating reductions to conserve on our expenses). When you factor in the increasing costs

of other utilities/necessities along with this much of an increase for just 1 utility company, it can cause ALOT of hardship on the taxpayers in Washington County. I am sure this complaint will be ignored and tossed aside without any importance but taxpayers should have a say and should be listened to. There needs to be someone or some company that is looking out the middle class citizens and attempting to relieve some burdens and stressors that is effecting so many.
