This program offered increasing access to AEP Ohio generation capacity at RPM pricing over the 3 year period such that existing shopping customers and an increasing number of new entrants could access the discounted capacity over the term of the plan. Although AEP Ohio should be entitled to collect their full cost for the capacity they are required to bring to the market, they conceded to this discount strategy to facilitate settlement of several contentious cases. This aspect of the stipulation was NOT the focus of the consumer uprising related to increased rates yet it was thrown out summarily with the main consumer culprits...the MTR and the Load factor rider. The culprits were revenue neutral to AEP Ohio and could have been resolved while leaving the capacity plan, and AEP Ohio's financial stability, in place. The Commission must resolve the capacity issue fairly and ASAP, then focus on AEPOhio's soon to be filed ESP. CRES providers are trying to create the illusion that FAIR capacity compensation for AEP Ohio will shutdown competition. The reality is that FAIR capacity compensation will only serve to boost their profits at the expense of AEPOhio employees and shareholders. The record has shown that end use customers can still find attractive shopping deals even at the suggested \$255/MW-day capacity charge, just less profit for the CRES's. Do the right thing ASAP!

On February 27, AEP Ohio filed a motion for relief and expedited action with the PUCO to halt the financial losses sustained as a result of the Commission's decision on February 23 to revoke its approval of the company's ESP plan, which the Commission had approved on December 14 and modified on January 23. We have requested that the Commission set the capacity charge that alternative suppliers must pay to use AEP's generating assets at \$255/MWday until a final ESP has been approved.
