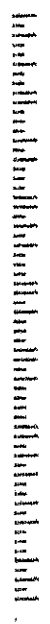

ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Section 4905.14, Revised Code, requires that every public utility, as defined by Section 4905.02, Revised Code, shall file an annual report at the time and in the form prescribed by the Commission. An on-line report form is again available for all competitive and wireless telecommunications service providers. Instructions are posted at www.puco.ohio.gov/puco/docketing. Each competitive service provider listed on Attachment A to this entry shall file its annual report in this docket by April 30, 2012. Each wireless telecommunications service provider listed on Attachment B to this entry shall create its assessment report using the on-line form, and submit it via electronic mail (e-mail) by April 30, 2012, in accordance with the posted instructions.
- (2) Section 4905.14, Revised Code, also requires that every public utility, except railroads, file a copy of its annual report with the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) at the same time that the report is filed with the Commission. Accordingly, each competitive and wireless telecommunications service provider shall send a copy of its annual report via e-mail to annualreports@occ.state.oh.us, or a paper copy to:
