### COMMENT DESCRIPTION:

AEP has fully embraced the state's decision to move to electricity competition and is prepared to move forward through a fair and reasonable transition much like other utilities did. During the last decade, with the support and encouragement of the PUCO, AEP Ohio committed its low-cost power plants to serve our customers and avoided implementing higher market rates. That commitment cannot be changed overnight and will last three years into the future.

Now competitors, most of whom don't have investments in Ohio and many who own no assets at all, want to use AEP Ohio's plants to serve customers using an arbitrary price as a basis for paying for the use of those plants. This price is extremely low, would have severe and immediate financial consequences for AEP, and could lead to unstable conditions for future investment in Ohio.

I am writing to ask the PUCO to please take immediate action and approve AEP Ohio's petition that will be filed later this month.

While a healthy competitive market MAY work in Ohio, allowing competition to "buy" the generation supply at the arbitary low capacity charge price instead of the true market price is unfair to AEP, and ultimately unfair the customer's who are offered that price. That price would only be available for a few years, and then the price would adjust to the then-market price anyway. Customer's will be significantly negatively impacted again in just a few years, and that will not look good for the PUCO or for competition in Ohio.

AEP Ohio has been a good corporate citizen for decades. They deserve to treated fairly in the matter. Today's edition of the Columbus Dispatchincluded an important editorial ("Reasonable Request") regarding the future of electric generation in Ohio. As you may be aware, our state is at a crucial moment in determining the environment for competitive retail generation where regulatory certainty and stability are critically important in order to attract jobs and investment in Ohio.

AEP has fully embraced the state's decision to move to electricity competition and is prepared to move forward through a fair and reasonable transition much like other utilities did. During the last decade, with the support and encouragement of the PUCO, AEP Ohio committed its low-cost power plants to serve our customers and avoided implementing higher market rates. That commitment cannot be changed overnight and will last three years into the future. Now competitors, most of whom don't have investments in Ohio and many who own no assets at all, want to use AEP Ohio's plants to serve our customers using an arbitrary price as a basis for paying for the use of those plants. This price is extremely low, would have severe and immediate financial consequences for AEP, and could lead to unstable conditions for future investment in Ohio.

To have a healthy competitive environment in any industry, more than one company needs to be capable of competing on a level playing field. Without a reasonable transition to a fair competitive framework, Ohio's economic recovery is not sustainable due to uncertainty for investors, and long term price instability for electric service.

I do believe that competitive electricity markets can work for Ohio. A fair transition to market with regulatory certainty can be successful for all Ohioans.

On February 27, AEP Ohio filed a motion for relief and expedited action with the PUCO to halt the financial losses sustained as a result of the Commission's decision on February 23 to revoke its approval of the company's ESP plan, which the Commission had approved on December 14 and modified on January 23. AEP requested that the Commission set the capacity charge that alternative suppliers must pay to use AEP's generating assets at \$255/MWday until a final ESP has been approved.

## **COMMENT DESCRIPTION:**

I would like to comment of the AEP cases currently before the commission (11-346-EL-SSO & 11-348-EL-SSO. I encourage the commission to act quickly to resolve this case. After careful review the PUCO approved a plan in December that could have been tweaked to address a narrow set of concerns by a small number of customers, however it chose to throw out the entire case and put a public company and the state of Ohio electric market in dire straits. While AEP is a regulated entity, is not a social pawn that should be gutted by bad public policy. That answer serves no one well, including the state, AEP and other electric providers. Other companies in the

electric market should also feel the chill of this decision. If the PUCO can complete such a capricious act, who says they would not do it to the others in the market. If AEP moves, is put out of business or has a low rate of return, what company in their right mind would invest to take their place? AEP deserves to earn a competitive rate of return based upon prudent investments and a fair transition to a competitive market that was afforded other companies. Allowing other companies to succeed on the backs of AEP Ohio just because it curries political favor that helps a small group serves no one well. While this decision may be difficult and at some point may adversely affect rates, that is the charge of the PUCO and competition was a path the PUCO chose over a decade ago. The PUCO is supposed to make decisions that are the public's interest, not in the interest of few. While there may be some that are hurt by a decision, the term "public" means everyone in Ohio is collectively better than they would have been. That you didn't like the answer for AEP, or a small group of customers or suppliers, throwing out the case is bad public policy and endangers many aspects of the electricity markets in Ohio. Quick resolution that maintains a strong public company and moves the state toward an orderly deregulation is in the best interest of the state. Putting AEP in dire financial straits simply raises their cost of doing business in the market (e.g. borrowing money) and further hurts Ohio ratepayers. Letting this issue linger puts a strong institution at risk, lowers confidence in the state of Ohio to govern, hurts our economic development, and makes the PUCO look further incompetent. If the PUCO wanst to become a social engineering organziation, do that in another way than through rate making. Do the right thing and approve the latest request by AEP, provide AEP a fair rate of return, support a deregulated environment that is fair to all, allow a public company to do with their assets what they are legally able to do and restore confidence in the state of Ohio.

As an employee (not a manager) at American Electric Power, I'm deeply concerned about the recent action that the PUCO has undertaken in Ohio. I was fortunate enough to be able to witness the POLR charge hearing last summer, and I found the hearing format to be reasonable, chaired

by a reasonable person, and had the impression that the PUCO was well organized, fair, balanced, and had the interests of all parties concerned in mind.

When the Commission, then, buckled to public pressure and completely revoked AEP's ESP filing recently, I was truly shocked by this apparent lack of direction, commitment, and focus.

First, I'm utterly baffled by the fact that the corporate separation of our generation units from our wires company was overturned, and have a difficult time understanding how this could potentially be bad for consumers. Second, I'm still trying to grasp this fact: AEP is somehow expected to transition to market immediately. The Commission may not know what AEP charges its operating companies for generation sourced in Ohio, but at the requested rate of \$255 per megawatt-day, you can trust me when I say that this is already deeply discounted. This is the kind of discount you would be thrilled to receive on anything else! Asking the company to provide generation to CRES providers at market rates - instantaneously - will cause heartburn for a lot of people, consumers and employees alike.

Let's say that you own a lot of power plants. You pay significantly more than \$255 per megawatt-day to generate your electricity. If someone offered to pay you \$17 per megawatt-day, you would probably rather shut the plant down and lay off the people who work there - it would be far less expensive than losing hundreds of dollars per unit sold. I'm not saying that this is what AEP plans to do - I have no knowledge of our contingency plans. But that's what I would do.

One of the perils of moving to market is that it can be extremely short sighted. Of course everyone wants the market rates when the market rates are low! But if power companies across the nation have to shut their plants down in order to stop hemorrhaging money, demand will exceed supply and the consumers will wind up sitting around in the dark. On the positive side of this, think about how much money they'll be saving! Personally, though, I'd rather have the lights on.

During about nine months out of the year, I pay less on my electricity bill than I do on my cable bill - and anyone who is reading this that does not have an all-electric household stands a good chance of being able to make the same statement. I don't even subscribe to premium channels! My point is this: at the prices that AEP is charging - even with the new rate structure - electricity is a far better value to me than anything else I pay for.

Finally, the difference to the consumer between paying \$17 per megawatt-day and \$255 per megawatt-day on a typical household usage of 1,000 KWh (1 MWh) per month is approximately (you can check my math): \$9.92. That might break the bank for some people, but I think most of us have spent that at Starbucks or McDonalds at one time or another.

Please allow AEP to make a graceful transition to market. We have been the low cost energy provider in Ohio for many years, and our rates are still among the very best in the state. Weakening any utility will result in less competition, higher prices, and indefinitely stalled economic growth in the state of Ohio. A strong AEP will provide strong competition for all utilities, and strong competition is what the market needs in order to benefit consumers, small businesses, and industry alike. Thank you.
