<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On March 30, 2012, DP&L filed an application for a standard service offer (SSO) pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code. This application is for a market rate offer in accordance with Section 4928.142, Revised Code. Additionally, DP&L filed accompanying applications for approval of revised tariffs, for approval of certain accounting authority, for waiver of certain Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders.
- (3) The Commission directs its Staff to investigate DP&L's applications and file Staff comments containing its recommendations for modifications to DP&L's application for an SSO or for such other SSO as Staff deems appropriate, as

well as DP&L's accompanying applications for approval of revised tariffs, for approval of certain accounting authority, for waiver of certain Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders.

- (4) The following procedural schedule is established for this proceeding:
 - (a) A technical conference will be held to allow interested persons the opportunity to better understand DP&L's applications. The conference will be held on April 12, 2012, at 9:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-B, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
 - (b) Staff comments should be filed by April 20, 2012.
 - (c) Motions to intervene should be filed by April 20, 2012.
 - (d) A prehearing conference should be held on April 23, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
 - (e) Testimony on behalf of intervenors should be filed by April 26, 2012.
 - (f) The evidentiary hearing shall commence on May 8, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (5) Moreover, DP&L should publish notice of the evidentiary hearing one time in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in DP&L's certified territories. The notices should not appear in the legal notices section of the newspaper. The notices should read as follows:

In this proceeding, the Commission will consider the company's applications, filed on March 30, 2012, requesting approval of a market rate offer for the supply of Standard Service Offer electric generation service beginning on January 1, 2013, approval of revised tariffs, approval of certain waiver of certain accounting authority, Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders.
