The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 12, 2012, Material Sciences Corporation (Complainant) filed a complaint against the Toledo Edison Company (TE) alleging that TE violated statutory and regulatory duties related to retail electric services provided to Complainant at its Walbridge, Ohio, facility.
- (2) On April 2, 2012, TE filed a motion for extension of the time to file an answer from April 2, 2012, to April 13, 2012, stating that the parties are engaging in ongoing settlement negotiations.
