## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 25, 2012, Donald E. Schaller (Complainant) filed a complaint against The Toledo Edison Company (Respondent) regarding damage to appliances and electrical equipment at Complainant's residence. Respondent filed an answer to the complaint and affirmative defenses on February 14, 2012.
