\* \*\*\*\*\*\*\*\*\* I have an all electric house. My bill jumped \$120 in January vrs. December on

about the same usage. That was about a 30% increase. My bill was about \$450. \$300 of it was for generation. I noticed that the winter discount for high usage electric was eliminated for Generation. This makes no sence. Other high use customers (comercial and Industrial) get lower rates. Why not residential? In the winter time there is excess generation available and all electric customers have a high load factor. Load is based mostly on outside temperature and may even be higher at night where there is even more generation available. There's no reason not to apply the winter high use discount for residential customers.
