>We've heard little about AEP's new rate proposal - that it would mean a slightly higher increase to average home owners and a significant reduction to businesses (compared to the plan passed Dec 2011). We heard no mention of how this will affect owners of all-electric homes. Like businesses we saw a 30% increase on our Jan, Feb, and March bills. I believe this was mostly due to the change in the base-generation rate; previously AEP charged it base-generation rate for only the first 800 kwh of usage during the cold-weather months; after the Dec 2011 rate went into practice the base-generation rate is the same for all usage levels. Our all electric home used 4000 kwh during the past mild January and our thermostat is set at 66 degrees. Has this change to the base-generation rate been removed from the new proposal? If not, it needs to be.
