ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On March 30, 2012, DP&L filed an application for a standard service offer (SSO) pursuant to Section 4928.141, Revised Code. This application is for a market rate offer in accordance with Section 4928.142, Revised Code. Additionally, DP&L filed accompanying applications for approval of revised tariffs, for approval of certain accounting authority, for waiver of certain Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders.
- (3) By entry issued April 2, 2012, the Commission established a procedural schedule for this proceeding.

- **(4)** Thereafter, on April 13, 2012, Ohio Energy Group, Staff, FirstEnergy Solutions Corp., Duke Energy Retail Sales, L.L.C., Duke Energy Commercial Asset Management, Inc., the Ohio Hospitals Association, and Honda of America Mfg., Inc. (collectively, Joint Movants), filed a joint motion seeking to extend portions of the procedural schedule. In their motion, Joint Movants request that a deadline to serve written discovery requests be established as April 27, 2012; the deadline for interested parties to intervene be extended to May 4, 2012; the deadline for intervenor testimony be extended to May 9, 2012; and, the hearing be continued until May 21, 2012. Joint Movants state that an extension of the procedural schedule will ease the burden on intervenors in this proceeding that are also currently involved in several other critical cases at the Commission.
- (5) Additionally, on April 16, 2012, DP&L filed a memorandum stating its agreement with the motion to modify the procedural schedule filed by Joint Movants.
- (6) The attorney examiner finds that Joint Movants' motion to extend portions of the procedural schedule is reasonable and should be granted, with modifications. In light of Joint Movants' request to continue the procedural schedule, as well as the other SSO filings currently before the Commission, the attorney examiner finds that the procedural schedule shall be modified as follows:
 - (a) Staff comments should be filed by April 27, 2012.
 - (b) A prehearing conference should be held on April 30, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
 - (c) Motions to intervene should be filed by May 18, 2012.
 - (d) Testimony on behalf of intervenors should be filed by June 13, 2012.
 - (e) The evidentiary hearing shall commence on June 25, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the

Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Hearing Room 11-A, Columbus, Ohio 43215.

(7) Moreover, DP&L should publish notice of the evidentiary hearing one time in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in DP&L's certified territories. The notices should not appear in the legal notices section of the newspaper. The notices should read as follows:

The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio has scheduled evidentiary hearings in Case Nos. 12-426-EL-SSO, 12-427-EL-ATA, 12-428-EL-AAM, 12-429-EL-WVR, and 12-672-EL-RDR, In the Matter of the Application of The Dayton Power and Light Company for Approval of its Market Rate Offer, for Approval of Revised Tariffs, for Approval of Certain Accounting Authority, for Waiver of Certain Commission Rules, and to Establish Tariff Riders. In this proceeding, the Commission will consider the company's applications, filed on March 30, 2012, requesting approval of a market rate offer for the supply of Standard Service Offer electric generation service beginning on January 1, 2013, approval of revised tariffs, approval of certain authority, waiver accounting Commission rules, and to establish tariff riders.

The evidentiary hearing will commence on Monday, June 25, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, Hearing Room 11-A, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
