The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 5, 2012, Vincent V. Johnson (Mr. Johnson) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). Mr. Johnson asserted that he did not open the accounts for which he is being charged on his bill, nor did he sign or agree to a continuing contract. He contended that his complaint has not been thoroughly investigated by CEI and that the name on the account is not his name.
- (2) On March 26, 2012, CEI filed a motion for extension of time and for expedited review. CEI explained that it needed additional time to investigate the matter. The attorney examiner granted the motion in an entry dated March 28, 2012.
- (3) The parties filed a joint motion to dismiss on April 16, 2012. The motion indicates that the parties have resolved all issues raised in the complaint. In addition, the parties request that the matter be dismissed with prejudice.
- (4) As such, the Commission finds that the parties' motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice is reasonable and should be hereby granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice be granted.

It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
