Pursuant to ordering paragraph #7 of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") March 20, 2012 Entry in Case No. 10-2387-TP-COI, all ILECs and CLECs are ordered to file by May 1, 2012 their necessary intrastate access tariff changes necessary to implement the Federal Communications Commission's November 18, 2011, Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in Docket No. 07-135 et al by May 1, 2012.

On April 10, 2012, Onvoy filed the necessary calculations demonstrating what Onvoy Ohio intrastate access charges need to be reduced effective July 1, 2012. Onvoy's interstate and intrastate switched access rates are usage sensitive and have a similar rate structure. Nearly all of Onvoy's Ohio intrastate switched access charges are below its corresponding interstate rate elements, with one exception. Onvoy's intrastate terminating common transport multiplexing rate needs to be reduced. First Revised Pages No. 69 and 70 have additional language to clarify those specific rates that are charge on a per minute of use and on an originating and terminating basis. First Revised Page No. 69 indicates the reduced multiplexing Terminating rate.

Onvoy's proposed effective date for the tariff pages is July 1, 2012.
