#### **EXHIBIT C**

New Knoxville Telephone Company (Applicant) hereby seeks approval to integrate its touchtone rates into its basic access line service rates. By doing so, the Applicant will eliminate a separate line item charge on customers' bills, which results in a simpler bill. While some of Applicant's customers do not currently pay for touchtone service, non-touchtone capability is so far outdated that it is no longer readily available in the Applicant's network so even those customers that do not pay for the service, receive it. Anecdotally, Applicant believes that few, if any, of its subscribers utilize or even own customer premise equipment (CPE) capable of out pulsing a rotary, rather than touchtone, signal.

Touchtone's ubiquitous nature within the network is codified in Ohio Revised Code 4927.01, which includes touch-tone dialing service within the definition of basic local exchange service. Accordingly, it is appropriate for the separate touch-tone rate to be included in the basic local exchange service rate for all customers.

## **EXHIBIT D** (Customer Notice)

The customer notice attached hereto will be included as a bill message on customer bills on May 15, 2012. In addition, on May 3, 2012, the notice was forwarded to the Commission-provided electronic mailbox (Telecomm-Rule07@puc.state.oh.us) in accordance with Ohio Adm. Code 4901:1-6-07. The attached affidavit will be executed and filed in this docket after the customer notice mails.

#### **CUSTOMER NOTICE**

The following notice will appear as a bill message on the Company's May 15<sup>th</sup> invoices. An Affidavit of notice will be provided on the 17<sup>th</sup> confirming the notice.

Effective with the June bill, the charge for touch-tone service will be included in the monthly basic access line rate for all customers. The vast majority of our customers will see no increase on their bills – the separate line item on the bill for touch-tone service will simply be eliminated and the charge included in the monthly exchange rate.

For the few customers who do not currently subscribe to touchtone, your monthly exchange rate will now include the \$1.00 for touch-tone service. Due to the changes in technology and state and federal regulations, touch-tone service is a standard feature on all access lines and can no longer be considered optional.
