## ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On May 4, 2010, the Commission issued Certificate No. 10-188G(1) to the village of Cadiz, Ohio (Cadiz) to provide natural gas governmental aggregation services. The expiration date for the certificate was April 26, 2012.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that a retail natural gas supplier wishing to renew a certificate shall file a renewal application "[n]o less than thirty and no more than one hundred twenty days prior to the expiration date ...."
- (3) On April 23, 2012, Cadiz filed a motion for extension of the expiration date of the certificate to May 26, 2012. On that same day, Cadiz filed its application for renewal of its certificate, less than 30 days prior to the expiration of Certificate No. 10-188G(1).
- (4) In its motion for an extension, Cadiz states that it can not file its renewal application because it is having difficulty obtaining executed documents. Cadiz asserts that the delay will not prejudice any party. Therefore, in order to provide the Commission with 30 days to review the application, Cadiz asks that the certificate expiration date be extended.
- (5) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 10-188G(1) is warranted; therefore, the motion for extension filed by Cadiz should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion for an extension filed by Cadiz is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the April 26, 2012, expiration date of Certificate No. 10-188G(1) is extended to May 26, 2012. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
