ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Mid State Systems Inc. (respondent), in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-12, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), alleging multiple violations of the Commission's transportation regulations.
- (2) On March 23, 2012, Lee Zazworsky filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, O.A.C, on behalf of respondent.
- (3) A prehearing settlement conference was held on April 19, 2012; however, the parties were unable to settle this matter.
- (4) By entry issued April 19, 2012, the attorney examiner issued an entry scheduling this matter for a hearing to commence on May 29, 2012.
- (5) On May 18, 2012, the parties filed a settlement agreement which proposes to resolve all of the issues in this case.
- (6) Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that the May 29, 2012, hearing shall be held in abeyance pending the Commission's consideration of the May 18, 2012, settlement agreement.

ORDERED, That the May 29, 2012, hearing be held in abeyance. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
