STANDARD CHOICE OFFER RIDER (SCO)

SCO Rider:

\$ 0.3959 rate per 100 cubic feet for all gas consumed each billing period. Company's monthly SCO Rider will be computed each month based on the NYMEX final settlement price for the month plus the Retail Price Adjustment determined through the SCO Auction converted from dollars per Mcf to dollars per Ccf for billing purposes.
