ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 29, 2010, in the above-captioned case, NextGen Energy Partners (NextGen), filed an application seeking certification for Scioto Valley Solar One, LLC (Solar One), 510 South Courtwright Street, McGuffey, Ohio, as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (2) Rule 4901:1-40-04(F)(2), O.A.C, provides for automatic approval of an application for certification as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility, unless the Commission suspends the application within sixty days. By attorney examiner entry issued on March 2, 2010, NextGen's application was suspended from automatic approval for certification.
- (3) On July 29, 2010, in Case No. 10-1056-EL-REN, Sol Systems, Inc., also filed an application seeking certification for 510 South Courtwright Street, McGuffey, Ohio as an eligible Ohio renewable energy resource generating facility.
- (4) On April 20, 2012, NextGen filed a request to withdraw its application that was filed in Case No. 10-101-EL-REN.
- (5) The Commission finds that NextGen's request to withdraw its duplicate application is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That NextGen's request to withdraw its application filed in Case No. 10-101-EL-REN be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties of record.




