ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- 1) On November 23, 1994, the Commission issued its opinion and order in these cases approving the joint stipulation filed on September 20, 1994, and granting the application of The Ohio Bell Telephone Company (also known as Ameritech Ohio) for approval of an alternative form of regulation to the extent provided in the order.
- 2) Subsequently, on December 8, 1994, Ameritech filed a pleading requesting clarification of certain provisions of the Commission's November 23, 1994 order. Memoranda contra Ameritech's request were filed by several parties on December 19, 1994.
- 3) On December 23, 1994, various parties who opposed the stipulation in these cases filed applications for rehearing of the Commission's November 23, 1994 order.
- 4) Upon review of Ameritech's request for clarification, we find it prudent to postpone our consideration of such request until we have had sufficient time to review and consider the

applications for rehearing which were filed on December 23, 1994. Therefore, without taking a position on whether Ameritech's filing is a proper application for rehearing and without accepting Ameritech's consent argument, we deem it prudent to rule on Ameritech's December 8, 1994 pleading within the context of our entry on rehearing in these matters.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That copies of this entry be served upon all parties of record.
