To the undersigned's understanding, the City is proceeding toward effectuating the physical closures of the Buckeye and Park Street crossings (with this expected to be accomplished in or about early July of 2012), thereby resolving a frequency saturation concern; in the meantime, the involved parties are proceeding with the requisite preliminary engineering relating to the

prospective circuitry work at various other City crossings, including Kercher Street, with same to be submitted for authorization following the City's closures of the above-referenced crossings.

Assuming necessary, Norfolk Southern will file a further Status Report by July 31, 2012.
