Matrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix"), as Successor in Interest to Substantially all of the Assets of Comtel Telcom Assets LP, hereby submits this correspondence in response to Case No. 12-05-TP-RPT entry dated June 13, 2012. The entry indicates that Comtel Telcom Assets LP ("Comtel") failed to file with the Commission its annual report for the calendar year 2012. It is Matrix's intent that the information provided herein will be sufficient to remove Comtel from this proceeding.

On August 2, 2010, Matrix Telecom, Inc. ("Matrix") and Comtel consummated an asset purchase agreement through which Matrix acquired substantially all of its assets, including customers, to Matrix. As a result of the asset sale, Comtel is no longer providing telecommunications services within Ohio or any other state. The existing customers were transferred to Matrix and Comtel has ceased providing telecommunications services as of the closing date. Comtel issued a notice requesting voluntary relinquishment to the Commission in August 2010.

Due to the aforementioned information, it was the Company's belief that the filing submitted by Matrix would satisfy the annual report requirement. Attached please find Comtel's annual report for the calendar year 2012 pursuant to the Commission's request.
