

This is in regard to case #12-1230-EL-SSO. As an all electric homeowner I've already seen some of the discount we were promised disappear and the remainder of the discount will be phased out in the next two years. Now First Energy is requesting an increase in the distribution rate. I am asking you to deny this request. This cost increase seems unnecessary in light of the recent rulings that led to the dissolution of the discounts and will lead to a substantial increase in costs as things presently stand. An increase in the distribution rate will lead to even higher energy costs for all and especially to all-electric homeowners. First Energy's latest quarterly shareholder report stated a profit of \$306 million, or 73 cents a share, up from \$52 million, or 15 cents, a year earlier. They seem to be doing quite well as things stand now. I am also concerned that with every ruling against homeowners on this issue that my home will suffer a significant decrease in value as electric costs rise at a greater rate than other energy sources. Please deny this rate increase and do not further punish all-electric consumers. We have and will continue to see rates rise based on past rulings. There is no need to burden us even more. It is not my fault that First Energy can't produce electricity at the same rate as AEP and other, better operated producers. It is not our place to absorb the penalty for their incompetent planning...a free market should address that...or PUCO in the absence of a free market.

First Energy needs stopped. They need to be held accountable for their poor planning and failure to keep their agreements. In the spirit of PUCO's charter, I'm asking you to stop FE's assault on those of us who are trapped and continue to be victimized by their deceptive, unconscionable business practices. If we dealt with FE in the same way they have dealt with us, FE would not hesitate to terminate service. Given their monopoly, our only hope for fairness is PUCO intervention.
