Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. ("CEGCI") was originally incorporated in Delaware in 1999 as MXenergy Inc. ("MXenergy") providing retail natural gas and electric power to residential and commercial customers in deregulated markets in the United States and Canada. On July 1, 2011, Constellation Energy Group, Inc. ("CEG") acquired MXenergy Holdings Inc. ("MXenergy Holdings"), the indirect parent company of MXenergy. MXenergy Holdings became an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of CEG with MXenergy continuing to be a wholly owned subsidiary of MXenergy Holdings. On March 12, 2012, CEG and Exelon Corporation ("Exelon") agreed to merge. Exelon became the ultimate parent of MXenergy although its direct parent continues to be MXenergy Holdings. On June 1, 2012, MXenergy changed its name to Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc.

CEGCI serves approximately 340,000 retail natural gas customers behind 29 natural gas utilities in 12 states and 2 Canadian provinces. CEGCI is a licensed Competitive Retail Natural Gas Supplier in Ohio (Certificate #02-021). Exelon is the leading U.S. competitive energy provider, with one of the cleanest and lowest-cost power generation fleets and largest retail customer bases in the country. The Exelon family of companies participates in every stage of the energy business, from generation to power sales to transmission to delivery. Headquartered in Chicago, the company has operations and business activities in 47 states, the District of Columbia and Canada. Exelon has approximately \$33 billion in annual revenues and trades on the NYSE under the ticker symbol EXC.

Constellation Energy Gas Choice, Inc. ("CEGCI") serves approximately 340,000 retail natural gas customers behind 29 natural gas utilities in 12 states and 2 Canadian provinces. CEGCI has been marketing natural gas to customers in the jurisdictions listed in Exhibit B-1 since 1999.

CEGCI performs its supply trading and scheduling operations with a team that includes physical and derivatives traders, schedulers, and analysts. The scope of activities performed by CEGCI staff includes:

- Purchasing short and long-term physical and financial gas supply requirements.
- Scheduling natural gas on 27 pipelines.
- Performing all supply forecasting and planning analysis.

CEGCI's supply team has 4 schedulers including 2 senior schedulers each with more than 10 years scheduling experience on more than 20 different pipelines and 3 supply traders each with more than 5 years experience. The supply team is lead by a supply manager with over 25 years of energy industry experience. In accordance with Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 4901:1-27-10 "Material changes in business", MXenergy Inc. ("MXenergy") herein provides notice to the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio of a significant change in MXenergy's ownership.

On July 1, 2011, Constellation Energy Group, Inc. ("Constellation") acquired MXenergy Holdings Inc. ("MX"), the indirect parent company of MXenergy. Prior to this acquisition, MX was a privately held company with about 125 stockholders. MX is now an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Constellation and MXenergy continues to be a wholly owned subsidiary of MX. In connection with this transaction, MXenergy has a new slate of officers and directors as described in Attachment A. Mr. Chaitanya Parikh has been promoted to President and CEO of MXenergy.

MXenergy will continue to sell natural gas to and service its Ohio customers on the same basis utilizing the same processes and systems as existed prior to the acquisition. The acquisition was independent of any service requirements to MXenergy customers and will not affect their contracts, rates or services.


