The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 27, 2011, Anita Deal filed a complaint with the Commission against The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) alleging that the company improperly charged her for electric usage at her residence.
- (2) DP&L filed an answer on January 12, 2012, denying the allegations in the complaint.
- (3) By entry issued May 1, 2012, this matter was scheduled for a settlement conference on June 1, 2012. Complainant, however, did not attend the conference.
- (4) This matter was rescheduled for a settlement conference on July 11, 2012. In the entry rescheduling the conference, complainant was advised that failure to attend the conference might result in a recommendation to the Commission to dismiss her complaint for lack of prosecution.
- (5) At the time of the July 11, 2012, settlement conference, a fire drill was conducted in the building housing the Commission's offices. All personnel on the premises, including Commission staff, evacuated the building. Although the settlement conference was convened at the conclusion of the fire drill, complainant did not attend the conference.
- (6) By entry issued July 12, 2012, complainant was directed to contact the attorney examiner in writing by August 1, 2012,

indicating whether she wished to proceed with the hearing process for this complaint. Further, complainant was advised that if she failed to communicate with the attorney examiner in writing by August 1, 2012, the examiner would recommend to the Commission that the complaint be dismissed for failure to prosecute.

(7) To date, the complainant has not contacted the attorney examiner regarding the disposition of her case. Accordingly, the Commission finds that this case should be dismissed and closed as a matter of record.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Case No. 11-6052-EL-CSS be dismissed and closed of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
