ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On August 24, 2011, Infotelecom, LLC (Infotelecom) filed a complaint against The Ohio Bell Telephone Company dba AT&T Ohio (AT&T Ohio) seeking resolution of a dispute regarding the appropriate interpretation of an interconnection agreement between Infotelecom and AT&T Ohio.
- (2) AT&T Ohio filed its answer on September 13, 2011.
- (3) Pursuant to the attorney examiner Entry of October 11, 2011, a settlement conference was scheduled for October 28, 2011.
- (4) On October 18, 2011, Infotelecom filed a petition for bankruptcy relief with the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Ohio (Bankruptcy Court).
- (5) On January 12, 2012, the Bankruptcy Court entered a Stipulated Order upon which Infotelecom and AT&T Ohio agreed to stay this proceeding until April 14, 2012.
- (6) On March 21, 2012, the Bankruptcy Court entered a second Stipulated Order upon which Infotelecom and AT&T Ohio agreed to stay this proceeding until July 5, 2012.
- (7) On July 3, 2012, Infotelecom and AT&T Ohio filed a joint motion to dismiss this complaint with prejudice inasmuch as the parties have settled all issues raised by the complaint.

- (8) The joint motion to dismiss is reasonable and should be granted. Therefore, the complaint is dismissed with prejudice.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That the motion to dismiss is granted with prejudice in accordance with Finding (8). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.




