ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On May 22, 2012, D.M. Bowman, Inc. (Respondent) filed a request for an administrative hearing in accordance with Rule 4901:2-7-13, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (2) On May 23, 2012, Respondent paid the civil forfeiture.
- (3) On July 31, 2012, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a motion to dismiss these cases. In the motion, Staff states that Respondent has paid the forfeiture in full.
- (4) Rule 4901:2-7-22, O.A.C., provides that payment of the forfeiture shall terminate all other proceedings regarding that violation.
- (5) In view of the payment of the forfeiture, the motion to dismiss should be granted, and these cases should be closed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, consistent with Finding (5), the motion to dismiss be granted and these cases be closed. It is, further,


ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.




