<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 26, 2012, Antoinette Watson, III (complainant) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI). The complainant alleges that the respondent unreasonably denied her application for service.
- (2) On April 16, 2012, CEI filed its answer denying the complainant's substantive allegations and setting forth affirmative defenses.
- (3) A prehearing settlement was held on June 13, 2012, as scheduled by entry issued on May 9, 2012.
- (4) On August 29, 2012, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint with prejudice, stating that the parties have reached a settlement in this proceeding.
- (5) The Commission finds that the motion to dismiss with prejudice is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the complaint should be dismissed.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That this complaint be dismissed with prejudice and closed of record. It is further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and of record.
