
Norfolk Southern has submitted updated plans and estimates for the prospective circuitry work to be performed at various of the City's crossings. The ORDC is reviewing same, and conducting a related field survey. Assuming the plans and estimates are approved, then these parties await confirmation from the City that the Buckeye Street crossing has been closed, as once this closure is confirmed, and again assuming the approval of the submitted plans and estimates,

then the ORDC will request that a construction authorization be issued for the prospective circuitry work.

Assuming necessary, Norfolk Southern will file a further Status Report by October 31, 2012.


