Exhibit A-12 "Corporate Structure"



MSI Utilities is in the business of Natural Gas and Electricity brokering. We work with commercial customers in various parts of the country to help manage utility costs. We started in the business as a Natural Gas agent for Utilicorp Energy Solutions (Energy One). Energy One's book of retail NG business was sold to Metromedia Energy in approx. 1999. At that point, we began acting as an agent for Metromedia Energy. We still work with MME as an agent in the North East, but have implemented additional suppliers in a number of other areas.

Market Solutions, Inc. was formed in 1995, and then MSI Utilities, Inc. in 2003. MSI Utilities was formed to assume the role of the primary operating company. Market Solutions, Inc. was merged into MSI Utilities in 2011.


