ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 14, 2012, American Broadband and Telecommunications Company (American Broadband or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T or respondent) concerning a billing dispute.
- (2) Pursuant to a joint motion to stay filed on July 10, 2012, the attorney examiner issued an entry on July 26, 2012, staying this proceeding until September 11, 2012, to allow the parties to continue the dispute resolution process.
- (3) On September 10, 2012, the parties filed a joint motion to extend the stay for an additional 60 days. The parties explain that they are continuing to make progress toward resolving their dispute and need additional time to reach a final resolution.
- (4) The parties have stated good cause to continue the stay. Accordingly, the parties shall be granted an additional 60 days, until November 19, 2012, to continue toward a resolution of the dispute. On or before November 19, 2012, the parties shall notify the attorney examiner concerning the status of the dispute.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (4), the parties' joint motion to extend the stay is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the parties file on or before November 19, 2012, a notice concerning the status of their dispute. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon all parties and interested persons of record.
