ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) The Dayton Power and Light Company (DP&L) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On June 29, 2012, DP&L filed an application to update its Reliability Targets, Customer Average Interruption Duration Index (CAIDI), and System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI) in accordance with Rule 4901:1-10-10, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), and the Commission's Opinion and Order in Case No. 09-754-EL-ESS issued on July 29, 2010.
- (3) On July 26, 2012, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel timely filed a motion and memorandum in support to intervene in this proceeding. The attorney examiner finds that the motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.
- (4) Consistent with Rule 4901:1-10-10(B)(6), O.A.C., and in order to accomplish the review of DP&L's proposed reliability standards, the attorney examiner finds that the following procedural schedule should be established:
  - (a) November 1, 2012 - A technical conference will be held at 11:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11<sup>th</sup> floor, hearing room 11-D, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
  - (b) November 20, 2012 - Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by any interested person.

- (c) November 30, 2012 – Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff.
- (d) December 20, 2012 – Deadline for the filing of reply comments.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to intervene filed by OCC be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in Finding (4) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
