Dear Chairman Snitchler:

I write today to express my support for ASHTA Chemicals reasonable arrangement currently pending before the PUCO. As a major employer in Ashtabula County, ASHTA makes a significant annual contribution to our local economy. In fact, ASHTA contributes more than eight million dollars annually towards our economy in wages and benefits for its employees while also paying more than \$500,000.00 in state and local taxes that support our community.

With the approval of this reasonable arrangement, I am told that ASHTA will invest more than \$50 million dollars in new manufacturing that will not only provide for an environmentally sound process but also allow for the investment of new technology that will permit ASHTA to remain competitive in our global economy. In addition, the \$50 million dollars in new investment will provide jobs through local contractors who perform the construction work.
