I have recently learned that ASHTA Chemicals has filed for a reasonable arrangement with First Energy so as to ensure its long term commitment to Ashtabula County and the State of Ohio. With over one hundred employees who account for an annual payroll of more than \$8 million, ASHTA is one of the major employers in our area. In fact, ASHTA has committed that with the approval of this reasonable arrangement, ASHTA will expend approximately \$50 million in new capital investment to institute state of the art manufacturing technology and retain more than 90 full time well-paying jobs in our community.

With its corporate offices and manufacturing based in Ashtabula, in addition to the well-paying employment opportunities, ASHT contributes nearly \$500,000 a year in support of our local communities through its payment of state and local taxes in Ohio. It is my understanding that in order for ASHTA to continue to grow, maintain and modernize its manufacturing facility here in town, a reasonable arrangement must be approved by PUCO.
