2. That the proposed Glenwillow Transmission Substation is to be located wholly within the Village of Glenwillow.





**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO
INTERVENE IN THE OHIO POWER SITING BOARD CASE
NO. 12-1727-EL-BSB AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, FirstEnergy is proposing to construct a large electrical substation and install additional electrical transmissions lines in the Village of Glenwillow as part of its proposed transmission line Project from Beaver County Pennsylvania to Glenwillow; and


WHEREAS, an application for this Project is expected to be soon filed before the Ohio Power Siting Board under Case No. 12-1727-EL-BSB; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Administrative Code grants the right to affected municipalities to intervene in its proceedings.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Glenwillow, County of Cuyahoga, and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to intervene in Ohio Power Siting Board Case No. 12-1727-EL-BSB.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared to be an Emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and this ordinance shall take immediate effect in accordance with the provisions of Article IV, Section 11 of the Charter of the Village of Glenwillow, Ohio.
