ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On March 19, 2012, Commission staff served a notice of preliminary determination upon Neier, Inc. (respondent), alleging violations of the Commission's transportation regulations. Thereafter, on April 4, 2012, respondent filed a request for an administrative hearing, thereby initiating this case.
- (2) Rule XII, Section 2(A) of the Government of the Bar of Ohio (Bar Rule) provides rules governing eligibility to practice *pro hac vice* in Ohio. Pursuant to Section 2(A)(6) of the Bar Rule, motions for admission *pro hac vice* must be accompanied by a certificate of *pro hac vice* registration furnished by the Supreme Court Office of Attorney Services.
- (3) On October 18, 2012, a motion for permission to appear *pro hac vice* on behalf of respondent and a certificate of *pro hac vice* registration with the Supreme Court of Ohio were filed by Timothy W. Wiseman in this case. The attorney examiner finds that the motion for permission to appear *pro hac vice* is reasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion for admission *pro hac vice* filed by Timothy W. Wiseman be granted in accordance with Finding (3). It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.
