ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) Ohio Power Company (AEP Ohio) is a public utility as defined in Section 4905.02, Revised Code, and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission.
- (2) On June 29, 2012, AEP Ohio filed an application to update its Reliability Targets, Customer Average Interruption Duration Index (CAIDI), and System Average Interruption Frequency Index (SAIFI) in accordance with Rule 4901:1-10-10, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.).
- (3) On July 26, 2012, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel timely filed a motion and memorandum in support to intervene in this proceeding. No memorandum contra was filed. The attorney examiner finds that the motion to intervene is reasonable and should be granted.
- (4) Consistent with Rule 4901:1-10-10(B)(6), O.A.C., and in order to accomplish the review of AEP Ohio's proposed reliability standards, the attorney examiner finds that the following procedural schedule should be established:
 - (a) December 11, 2012 - A technical conference will be held at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th floor, hearing room 11-B, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
 - (b) January 4, 2013 - Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by any interested person.
 - (c) January 14, 2013 - Deadline for the filing of comments on the application by Staff.

- (d) January 22, 2013 – Deadline for the filing of reply comments.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the motion to intervene filed by OCC be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the procedural schedule set forth in Finding (4) be adopted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
