The Commission finds:

- (1) This civil forfeiture case was filed on September 4, 2012. Thereafter, a prehearing conference was held in the matter.
- (2) On October 24, 2012, Commission Staff (Staff) filed a motion to dismiss the case. In its motion, Staff stated that further prosecution of this matter is not warranted. Accordingly, Staff requested that this proceeding be dismissed and that the violation be removed from the respondent's records.

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served upon each party of record.


